A Mobile Crisis Unit may be needed if your client is experiencing, or at risk of, a psychological crisis and requires a mental health intervention. This method can be more efficient than calling 911 in the case of a psychological crisis.

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An individual can be referred to a Mobile Crisis Team if they are experiencing or at risk of experiencing a psychological or psychiatric crisis, and are unable or unwilling to access care in the community. The goal of the Mobile Crisis Team is to assess the person and family needs, help to manage the situation and connect the person to services of his or her choice in the community. Mobile Crisis Teams can be made up of nurses, social workers, psychologists and psychiatrists, community liaisons and peers. Services are short term, usually up to two weeks. NYC Well is the single point of access for Mobile Crisis Team Services for NYC.

Providers requesting a mobile crisis referral for an individual in their care can expedite their request by submitting their request online during the hours of 9am to 4:30pm Monday through Friday (excluding holidays). NYC Well's MCT online referral form is a short, one-page form that takes about 10 minutes to complete.

- 1- **Administrative Services Unit:** member learns clerical skills, leadership roles in training and providing support to newer members.
- 2- **Housing and Maintenance Unit:** member will learn, painting, ordering supplies, gardening, electrical maintenance, cleaning, working with contractors.
- 3- **Kitchen and Dining Room Unit:** member learn how to prepares lunches and dinners from scratch as well food shopping, food ordering and inventory, table waiting, table setting, cleaning.
- 4- **Employment and Education Unit:** member will training in job readiness, job application, job interview, computer literacy, full participation in job development meetings and trainings.
- 5- **Evening and Weekend Social Programs:** Social and recreation program provides member the opportunity to enjoy and create relationships, activities including bowling, movies, museum visits and more.
- 6- **Wellness and Advocacy:** weekly exercise, dance class, yoga, nutrition programs, access to local fitness center.
